We offer incorporation to our team via Predoctoral fellowship (2020 la Caixa-Retaining call). The candidate will carry out the PhD thesis in the field of cardiovascular disease prevention and imaging, with a particular focus on health promotion in adolescents. Incorporation expected by September 2020

Mandatory requirements:

- o Graduate in Medicine with an academic record with average grade over 8 (out of 10) plus a Master's degree or/and FSE (spanish acronym for specialized health training)
- Candidates must be in the first 4 years (full-time equivalent research experience) of their research careers and not yet have been awarded a doctoral degree.
- Candidates must have resided or have carried out their main activity in Spain for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the call deadline.
- Level of English: Candidates must have a demonstrable level of English (B2 or higher).

Assessable requirements:

- FSE in cardiology, pediatrics or epidemiology.
- Experience in research centers and hospitals, both national and international, will be valued.
